

Criteria for publication in the Journal "Geopolitics"

"Geopolitics" is Marin Barleti University's Journal.

Its publication criteria match the criteria established by the Commission on the Evaluation of Academic Titles in the Republic of Albania. The paramount principle of Journal "Geopolitics" is its scientific scrutiny.

Geopolitics is released on a semi-annual basis.

Articles that are published in Geopolitics, may be either scientific or reviews. For the publication of translations, the author should send a copy of the original article together with a confirmation of the publication (copyright).

Each article should be written in the Albanian standard language. Articles should be sent in a Word format, and be accompanied by a summary (abstract) in the English language, and a short CV of the author(s), not exceeding ½ page.

As a rule, articles should be 8-10 computer pages long, each page containing 2200 characters, while the reviews, not longer than 3 pages.

Articles need to be equipped with footnotes, or endnotes. References are obligatory. The system of references used by "Geopolitics" reflects that of the Harvard system, meaning, that references should be indicated along the pages of the articles, and listed at the end of article, according to the alphabetical order of the authors. References should comprise the following elements:

a. References of the books

1. Author/or authors; 2. Year of publication; 3. Book title (in Italic); 4. Country/city of the publication; 5. Publisher's name
Example: Sen, Amartia. 2011. Zhvillimi si liri (Development as Freedom), Tiranë: Dudaj.

b. References from the scientific reviews or compilations:

1. Author/Authors; 2. Year of publication; 3. Article's title; 4. Title of the Journal/Compilation, where the article has been included (in Italic); 5. Volume and edition number, and pages.
Example: Bruce, Haddock. 2010. "Demokracia, stabiliteti dhe Europa: Tranzicioni në një kontekst më të gjerë", (Democracy, stability and Europe: Transition in a wider context) Gjeopolitika, Vëll. 2, Nr. 4, fq. 32-38.

Complete references listed at the end of the article should correspond to the abbreviated references indicated throughout the text, which are incorporated in the form illustrated below:

For one single author: Marshall (1998); (Marshall 1998:156); or Marshall (1998:156);

For two authors: Kadare & Bosquet, 1990.

For three authors: Kadare, Simic & Frckoski, 2001

For more than three authors: Kadare ed al., 2001

For series of references: Omari 1990; Meidani, 2000; Kadare, 1995; Uçi, 2003.

In cases when references are coming from the same author, from publications of the same year, then the reference is indicated as: 2011a, 2011b, etc.

Criteria for publication in the Geopolitics Journal are strictly academic. Every article that is presented for publication is submitted to a blind review. Articles are sent for review to two researchers of the same area. The article is published only when the two reviews are positive. If from the two reviews one is positive and the other negative, the article is sent to a third reviewer, whose decision is determining. Thus, the task of selection of the scientific articles is realised entirely by anonymous experts.
