PROFILE

Prof. Dr. Tomasz Ochinowski a graduate of philosophy in the field of psychology at ATK (currently UKSW), doctor of psychology (KUL), habilitated doctor of management sciences (UW). Research and didactic worker at the Faculty of Management at the University of Warsaw. 2004-2020 there he headed the Department of Sociology of Organizations and Business History (it was the first unit in Poland devoted to the organizational past). Currently the organizer of the Center for Organizational History ibid. He also conducts MBA classes, International Business Program and postgraduate studies, especially for HR managers, health care, art market management, sales services and contact centers. He delivered presentations and guest lectures at the University of Houston (USA), Vlerick Ghent Business School (Belgium), at several Taiwan universities and at the University of Trnava (Slovakia). For many years he lectured at ATK and the Pontifical Faculty of Theology in Warsaw, where he co-created the program of the Salesian Institute of Christian Education (now the Pedagogical Faculty of UKSW), in which he was the deputy director, and the program of the Study of Family Life. He was also a long-term lecturer, and periodically also vice-dean of the Faculty of Management at the University of Management and Entrepreneurship. Bogdan Jański in Warsaw.

He was a scholarship holder of the Scientific Research Support Program of the Central European University (winner of the 2nd prize for research achievements). He was an expert of the European Union in the field of local development. Researcher of the history of the organization and creator of international cooperation in this field. It develops the historiography of the organization (a critical analysis of the narrative about the past for the needs of managerial practice) both as a department of humanities management and a tool for improving managerial skills, which it implements through training and consulting.
